



Directions from Schiphol to Rotterdam Central Station

- When you arrive at Schiphol you will enter a big square in the arrival hall on this square will be the entrances to the train platforms.
- Many train that departure from Schiphol station will pass Rotterdam Central Station. The main suggestion therefore is to check the monitors on the square to guide you to the right platform.
- The easiest option is to take an 'intercity direct'. This train will take you directly to Rotterdam Central Station without any stops in between. This could be the intercity direct with the final destination of either Rotterdam Central Station, Breda or Brussels.

Tip: Google Maps can show you which platform or train is the quickest and most efficient.

Directions from Rotterdam Central Station Erasmus University Rotterdam

- When arriving at Rotterdam Central Station, make sure to take the exit on the side of the metro's and trams.
- Directly to the left when exiting the metro is the main Tram station.
- At this station you can take either tram 24 or tram 21, both with the final destination 'De Esch'.
- Exit the Tram at station 'Woudestein' (this is the 10th stop after getting on)
- After exiting the tram walk past straight past the football stadium and cross the Burgemeester Oudlaan.
- At the Bayle Building turn right at the Thomas Morelaan
- Walk straight past the Van der Goot building and at the Tinbergen Plaza enter the Mandeville Building (morning programme) or turn left to walk straight ahead towards the Paviljoen.

Suggestion:

If you use Google Maps, you can select the exact building you need to be at. This will show you a route guiding both on your ride with public transport and your walk. Check the programme to see in which building a specific activity takes place.

Tip: You can use your debit card to pay for your trip on public transport.
